- A** 22nd Street from I-10 / Greenway to 10th Avenue (south side)
 - 1 Greenway connections
 - 2 Alley connections
 - 3 Redevelopment / redesign opportunities (ie., residences)
 - 4 Pedestrian / bike crossings
- B** 22nd Street from 9th Avenue to 6th Avenue (south side)
 - 5 Alley connections
 - 6 Opportunities for redevelopment (vacant lots)
- C** 22nd Street between 6th Avenue & 4th Avenue (south side)
 - 7 Historic preservation / interpretation opportunities
 - 8 Alley connections
- D** 22nd Street between 4th Avenue to UPRR (south side)
 - 9 Residences on south side of 22nd Street
 - 10 Effect of bridge or underpass on ADOT park and residences
 - 11 Design opportunities at crossing
- E** 22nd Street at South Park & Millville (south side)
 - 12 Borton School - pedestrian access / school safety / safe routes / TUSD bus operation
 - 13 Redevelopment / redesign / interpretation opportunities
 - 14 South Park connections
- F** 22nd Street & Kino Parkway (north side)
 - 15 Bike route connection to Kino Parkway
 - 16 Kino Parkway / 22nd Street Interchange
 - 17 Redevelopment opportunities
- G** Millville Neighborhood (north side)
 - 18 Vacant lots for shared business parking & secondary access
